## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-012

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF INDIAN TRAIL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT SUPPORTING THE LOCAL BILL SUBMITTED IN THE 2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION WHICH WOULD REQUIRE A REFERENDUM ON THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE VILLAGE OF LOXAHATCHEE (INDIAN TRAIL AREA) SHOULD BE CREATED, AND WHETHER THE INDIAN TRAIL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, AN INDEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICT, SHOULD BECOME A DEPENDENT DISTRICT OF THE VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 2021-250, Laws of Florida, passed by the 2021 Florida Legislature, authorized the Indian Trail Improvement District ("the District") to, among other things, expend funds for the purposes of determining the feasibility of municipal conversion of the District via referendum pursuant to Section 165.0615, F.S.; and

WHEREAS, the legal requirements for conducting a referendum would be followed, including but not limited to publication of Notice; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the District supports the passage of the Local Bill submitted in the 2022 Legislative Session which would require a referendum on the question of whether the Village of Loxahatchee (Indian Trail Area) should be created, and whether the District, an independent special district, should become a dependent district of the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Indian Trail Improvement District:

- 1. The recitals contained hereinabove are considered true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The Board of Supervisors supports the Local Bill submitted in the 2022 Legislative Session which would require a referendum on the question of whether the Village of Loxahatchee (Indian Trail Area) should be created, and whether the Indian Trail Improvement District, an independent special district, should become a dependent district of the Village.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
